This culture trip is curated to celebrate the eroticism in temple art forms as well as to reveal the esoteric hidden

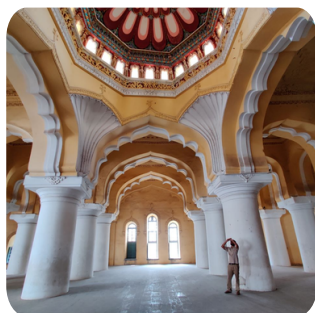
Day 1
